It was proposed by Mr Ingert and seconded by Mr Fisher and unanimously resolved that a Committee be appointed in Shelbridge together with a Treasurer and collector or collectors to arrange for the collection of subscriptions and for any other purposes that may crop up in connection with ^{the} administration of the sums so collected. This was carried unanimously.

It was proposed by Mr Maumder and seconded by Mr Fisher that the Parish Council together with The Revd J Hill Hoogood and Mr E Ingert be appointed as the Committee with power to add to their number if so desired.

It was unanimously resolved to ask Mr Maumder to accept the office of Treasurer and ^{which he very kindly consented to do} and Mr Ingert very kindly volunteered to collect subscriptions for ^{the} Fund.

The question of calling further meetings was left to the discretion of the Chairman and Clerk such meetings to be called when and as they thought necessary.

It was announced at the meeting that the sum of £29-8-6 had been collected in the Parish towards the County Patriotic Fund and sent to the Treasurer at Exeter. This was considered very satisfactory for the parish.
