It was proposed by Mr Gibson & seconded by Mr E. Cole that the clerk be instructed to write to the Wilveridge & also the Mid-Dawson council. The following points to be made.

- (a). The gravest concern at Witheridges' territorial aspirations.
- (b). A mini survey has been carried out by Mr Gibson & the residents were not overly concerned in which parish they resided.
- (c). Request Mid. Devon council to move 30 mph & approach sign further back towards Numansland.
- (d). Concessionary fares for Old Age Pensioners. This presumably is unaffected, whichever parish the O.A.P. resides. - (Bus).
- (e) Sewerage to be made available to Thelbridge parishioner at Witheridge Village Hall 1p rate. A motion proposed by Mr R. Cole & seconded by Mr Webber, that a penny rate be raised, as a grant to the parish Hall, for the provision of mains water & toilets. Unanimous
